READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE YOU BEGIN.

Create and submit a <u>video</u> recording (**unlisted** video on YouTube.com) of each of the following three audition segments.

You will submit a total of three videos.

- 1. Video recording of yourself singing all scales and triads (One major scale + three minor scales + four triads).
 - a. Before you begin, say your name.
 - b. Identify which scale or triad you are singing before you begin singing it.
 - c. Sing from memory.
 - d. Use hand signs if you are able.
 - e. Starting pitches for scales and triads: as noted on your voice part sheet
 - f. You can use any instrument or device to get your starting pitch.
- 2. Video recording of yourself singing "Measure Me, Sky" mm. 1-12. (Note: mm. 1-3 are rests, but you can leave them in your audition recordings.)
 - a. Before you begin, say your name and which part you are singing.
 - b. You should sing with the recording playing the accompaniment so the accompaniment is also heard in your video. Make sure you can be heard above the recording.
- 3. Video recording of yourself singing "Star Spangled Banner" a cappella. (Sing the entire piece.)
 - a. Before you begin, say your name.
 - b. Recommended starting pitches (any of these will work): D, Eb, E
 - c. This piece should be from memory because it's the national anthem. Look up the words if you don't know them.
 - d. Do not add any extra notes, ornaments, or anything else (including high notes on "land of the free").

Submit each video as a separate Unlisted YouTube video in the form. You will be submitting three videos in total.
